

NWTCA Vaccination Announcement



ATTENTION ALL CHAMPIONSHIP PARTICIPANTS

We are a proud member association of Curling Canada, and we are following their lead in making Covid-19 vaccinations mandatory for our events here in the North. The NWTCA's top priority is the health, safety, and well-being of all our participants and curlers, and all those in their affected circles. We are working with public health officials, Sport North, and Curling Canada to provide the most current information.

Effective for the 2021-2022 season, the NWT Curling Association is making COVID-19 double vaccinations mandatory to participate in any of the NWTCA Curling events. These events include our competitions, camps, clinics, and in-person meetings.

This policy will be in effect for all athletes, coaches, officials, staff, ice technicians, contractors, volunteers, media, and fans 12 years of age and older. All NWTCA coaches, instructors, and consultants (from the NWT or otherwise) will be required to be fully vaccinated and wear masks when working with youth.

As of December 13, 2021 – Individuals must be fully vaccinated, defined by a period of at least 14 days having passed since receiving their second dose of a two-dose Covid-19 vaccine series, and provide a proof of full vaccination.

A more detailed release and processes in submitting proof of vaccination will be coming shortly, we appreciate your patience and cooperation in helping to keep all participants safe and healthy.
