## **NWTCA Coaching Consultants**

The NWTCA will consider exemptions for current and former high-performance curlers to coach teams at NWT Championships only.

## **Eligibility and Process for Applying**

- Coaching Consultant's must request an exemption from the NWTCA to coach a team at a NWT Championship
- Exemptions will be granted on a case by case basis. Each championship a coach wishes to attend must be applied for separately and will be considered independent of any other application.
- Exemptions may be requested for an additional championship however it is highly recommended that Coaching Consultant's become Competition Coach Certified
- Individuals must be 16 years of age or over. Coaching consultants under the age of 21 must have an adult chaperone accompany them and the team.
- Individuals must have taken and passed the online Making Ethical Decision's Module
- Junior curlers must have participated in a minimum of two National Curling Championships and are currently being coached by a Certified Competition Coach
- Adult's must illustrate their competitive experience. Details could include any territorial or national competitions.
- All of the parents of junior athletes must sign off agreeing to allow an individual to coach a team as a Coaching Consultant
- It is recommended that the Coaching Consultant identify a "Coaching Mentor" who will work with the coach at the NWT Curling Championship
- All exemption requests will be approved or denied by the NWTCA High Performance Director. All exemption requests will be sent by email to nwtcurling@gmail.com. Exemption requests will include the following:
  - Name of proposed Coaching Consultant
  - List of curling achievements and experience
  - Proof that the Making Ethical Decisions course has been completed
  - Proof that all parents of the athletes agree that the Coaching Consultant can coach the athletes
  - Name of the coach mentor
  - Team name to be coached
  - Identify which NWTCA event is being requested
